Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Near Sant Achyut Maharaj Heart Hospital, University- Mardi Road, Ghatkheda, Amravati-444602, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0451) inspection was conducted on 20.03.2025 and 21.03.2025 via Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process Annual visitation for issuance of Yearly Permission with intake capacity of of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 1st renewal of permission for increase in intake capacity from 60 Seats to 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 12 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely:-(i) Kayachikitsa -06 seats (ii) Shalya tantra- 04, (iii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga- 02 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024 ", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, MESAR PG Ayurvedaa 2024, and relevant Regulations there under and following defects/ shortcoming were found in the assessment -

1. For Teaching Staff:-

a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is

b) Shortcoming for UG teaching staff is as below : -

2. Other infrastructure details:-

a) Animal house is not available.
b) Central research laboratory is not available.

- 3) Accordingly, as per the revised policy letter issued on 20.01.2025, "The 10% Relaxation in the requirement of the teaching staff may be extended for the Academic year 2025-26. Therefore, the colleges with 60 and 100 intake capacity shall have minimum of 27 and 40 teaching staff respectively fulfilling the requirements of the individual departments separately, so teaching staff is fulfilled however, other shortcomings were communicated to you vide letter of even no. dated 23.05.2025. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide letter ref. no. DRGACHRC/COL/638/2025 dated 24.05.2025.

4) Accordingly, the submitted clarification and the assessment report was once again carefully examined in terms of concerned Acts & Regulations and provision under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations **thereunder, and after verification observation is as under:-**

5) The assessment report and the submitted clarification were duly placed in the **131st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 04.07.2025** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the **Concerned Acts and regulations** but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of **Extended permission** in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on **09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025**. Hence, the Board decided to issue the **yearly permission** with intake capacity of **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and **1st renewal of permission** for increase in intake capacity from **60 Seats to 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** and **12 seats in 03 PG courses** in the subject namely **-(i) Kayachikitsa -06 seats (ii) Shalya tantra- 04, (iii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga- 02 seats** under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session **2025-26**.

"DECISION"

6) Therefore, Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Near Sant Achyut Maharaj Heart Hospital, University- Mardi Road, Ghatkhera, Amravati-444602, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0451) is hereby granted with **Yearly permission** with intake capacity of **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and **1st Renewal of permission** for increase in intake capacity from **60 seats to 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** and **12 seats in 03 PG courses** in the subject namely:-(i) Kayachikitsa -06 seats (ii) Shalya tantra- 04 Seats (iii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga- 02 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 subject to the condition that the following requirements shall be fulfilled: -

I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 12 seats in 03 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

7) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

8) Further, as per **Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**

9) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

10) The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for the Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024
- v) The remaining visitation fee as communicated in the letter dated 28.01.2025.

11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.



With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

ID - AYU0451), your college was visited on 11.01.2024 & 12.01.2024 for the issuance of LOI for increase the intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS), course from 60 seats to 100 seats and to start 03 New PG Courses with 12 Seats in the subjects namely :-(i) Shalya Tantra -04 Seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa - 06 seats & (iii) Striog Evum Prasuti Tantra -02 seats, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2024 and Letter of Intent (LOI) has been issued to your college for the same **vide letter of even no. dated 04.03.2024**.
2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on **21.03.2024 & 22.03.2024 through Hybrid mode** to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities available as a part of annual visitation **for issuance of conditional permission for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25** and for issuance of Letter of Permission for increase the intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS) from 60 seats to 100 seats and to start 03 New PG Courses with 12 Seats in the Subject namely :-(i) Shalya Tantra -04 Seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa - 06 seats & (iii) Striog Evum Prasuti Tantra -02 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25.
3. Further, in view of above assessment report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/defect have been observed-**
 - a) Availability of teaching staff for the issuance of LoP for increase intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS), course from 60 seats to 100 seats is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{9}{10} \times 100\% = 90\%$.

- Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the 99th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 26.07.2024. Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria. However, the college is fulfilling the criteria required for issuance of conditional permission as per the Regulation 3 (3) of MSR 2016. Hence, the Board decided to grant conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and issuance of Letter of Permission for increase the intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 60 seats to 100 seats and to start 03 New PG Courses with 12 Seats in the Subject namely :-(i) Shalya Tantra -04 Seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats & (iii) Striog Evum Prasuti Tantra -02 seats under section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 from academic session 2024-25.
- Further, in accordance of the regulation 6 (2)(i) (i) and 6 (3) (j) (II) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 vide letter of even no. dated 31.07.2024 a letter was sent to you to furnish fixed security deposit worth Rs. 50 Lakhs (Fifty lakhs Rupees Only) as fixed security deposit for a period of five years (05) to issuance of L.O.P for increase intake of seats in UG (BAMS) course from 60 seats to 100 seats and Rs. 1.5 Crore (One Crore Fifty lakhs Rupees Only) as fixed security deposit for a period of three years in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine. - Therefore, Conditional Permission is issued to Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Hospital & Research Center Amravati- 444602, Maharashtra (Inst. ID – AYU0451) for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) Course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and Letter of Permission (LOP) is issued for increase the intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 60 seats to 100 seats and to start 03 New PG Courses with 12 Seats in the Subject namely :-(i) Shalya Tantra -04 Seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats & (iii) Striog Evum Prasuti Tantra -02 seats from the academic session 2024-25, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions that the college shall fulfill the aforementioned shortcoming along with the following requirements:-

 - The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 12 seats in 03 PG Courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

 - Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any

time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stop page of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

9. **Discrepancies**, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.



11. **This permission for increase in intake capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 60 seats to 100 seats and to start 03 New PG Courses with 12 Seats in the Subject namely :-(i) Shalya Tantra -04 Seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa - 06 seats & (iii) Striog Evum Prasuti Tantra -02 seats from the academic session 2024-25 as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2024-25 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act 2020.**

12. **The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.**



With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

ID - AYU0451)** inspection of your College was conducted on **01.06.2023 & 02.06.2023** on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.**
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **45th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **30.06.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, hence Board decided to issue the Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.**
4. Therefore, **conditional permission is granted to Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Near Sant Achyut Maharaj Heart Hospital, Mardi Raod, Ghatkheda, Amravati - 444602 Maharashtra (Inst. 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

7. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2024-25: -**

- i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda).
- iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and

8. The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.

On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria. Hence Board decided to issue the Conditional permission for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23.**
4. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to **grant conditional permission to Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Near Sant Achyut Maharaj Heart Hospital, University, Mardi Road, Ghatkheda, Amravati-444602, Maharashtra, (Inst. 

On examining the same, it was observed that the No higher faculty available in the department of Dravyaguna against the minimum requirement of 01, Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff, Web based computerized central registration system and X-ray, ECG and USG were not available. Therefore, under

The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS).

4. It has been decided by the Central Government for ***grant of conditional permission*** to the **Dr. Rajendra Gode Ayurved College, Hospital & Research Centre, Mardi Road, Amravati- 444602, Maharashtra** with 60 seats in (UG) BAMS course for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, ***subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018:***


